

ROLE BRIEF

HIGH CHIEF RANGER

This role is of a Presidential nature and elected annually serving for 12 months. The post-holder will act as a figurehead for the membership. They will therefore represent and promote The Ancient Order of Foresters at both internal and external events.

Main Duties

- Keep apprised of matters relating to the Society's activities.
- Liaise with the Board, Chairman and executive team as appropriate.
- Represent the Society at meetings including:
 - Attendance at Area Meetings as invited.
 - Attendance at Court Meetings or functions as invited.
 - Attendance at other public. Charitable or benevolent functions.
 - Attendance at the annual High Court and performing ceremonial duties.
 - Chair Benevolence Committee and/or Members Forum as required.
- Participate in society and other public events including, on occasions, speaking duties.
- Maintain overall understanding of the way the Society conducts its business and the Strategic direction of the Society.
- Commitment to charitable, community and benevolent activities.

Based at: Home, but the role will involve significant travel around the UK.

Hours of work: There will be no set working hours, however it is envisaged that the role will require a commitment of approximately 40 hours per month. There will be a requirement to attend many membership, social, community and charitable functions, which often will involve weekend and evening commitments.
